



Risk Assessment Update- 9.6.21

Portesham CE VA Primary School

Rationale:

Covid rates within the county continue to be lower than many within the country. As a school, our entire pupil body reflects a size of a single bubble within other establishments. Additionally, the number of siblings within the school increases the risk of both bubble closures and we believe this move will support the academic progress and wellbeing of the school body.

As a school, we will continue to ensure that robust hygiene measures are in place and all other measures within the risk assessment remain the same unless stated below.

The following adjustments have been made:

- School will form a whole bubble
- Masks will continue to be worn by staff whenever they are in corridors however, within the staffroom, a degree of flexibility will be allowed to reflect the new bubble changes and the purpose of the facility.
- EYFS/KS1 and KS2 will be permitted to mix however, this will be avoided wherever possible.
- Visitors will be permitted to site by prior arrangement and agreement with SLT
