



Risk Assessment Update

04.1.21 Portesham CE VA Primary School

School site closed to most pupils apart from Critical Workers and Vulnerable-Remote Learning

As of Monday 4th January we closed the site as we are unable to presently staff the site safely in the normal capacity. A decision was taken to move to remote learning for most pupils and for provision on site to remain for critical worker and vulnerable pupils. This change has impacted on the current position of the risk assessment as the volumes are now different and a new bubble has now been formed. Whilst a new bubble has been formed, the risk assessment expectations remain the same for pupils any amendments to the risk assessment are outlined below.

Changes to risk assessment:

- New bubble pupils are required to stay within the hall, toilet and handwashing facilities within this location on site. Pupils are to access the playground through the side gate, with adult supervision.
- Staff are required to wear a mask whenever they are within 2 meters of another member of staff and it is advised that staff continue to use this when working within the hall bubble.
- Social distancing is encouraged and should be maintained wherever possible
- Staff working within the Critical worker and vulnerable bubble, continue to have access to staff toilets and the school site and must adhere to previously outlined expectations when moving through site.
- Critical worker bubble, staff are able to work flexibly to rota their time within the bubble and use the space to support ample social distancing.

We continue maintain the standards already outlined within our risk assessment and will continue to uphold the isolation period change highlighted within the previous update on 2.1.21.
